Prokill UK Limited is making a voluntary **modern slavery** and human trafficking statement in accordance with the **Modern Slavery Act 2015**.

We oppose **slavery** and human trafficking in all its forms and make this statement to set out the steps we have taken to ensure that there is no **slavery** or human trafficking in our business or in our supply chains. We are a franchise company for franchisees providing pest control services.

Our annual turnover is under £36 million. Although we are not required to make a **modern slavery** statement under section 54 of the **Modern Slavery Act 2015**, we are making this voluntary statement to show our commitment to ethical trading principles and to set out the steps we are taking to tackle **modern slavery** and human trafficking in our business and in our supply chains.

POLICIES OR OUR COMMITMENT TO ETHICAL TRADING

This statement reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure **slavery** and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in our supply chains.

DUE DILIGENCE AND RISK ASSESSMENT

To help identify and monitor the risk of **slavery** and human trafficking in our supply chain we vet suppliers and sub-contractors to ensure that they are committed to ethical labour practices. We include anti-**slavery** and human trafficking provisions in all our contracts with suppliers.

We only employ agency workers through reputable employment agencies that adhere to the Modern Slavery Act 2015



TRAINING

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of **modern slavery** and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we provide training to our staff. We also require our business partners to provide training to their staff and suppliers and providers.
